Is a way of living that recognizes our world is an increasingly complex web of connections and interdependencies.

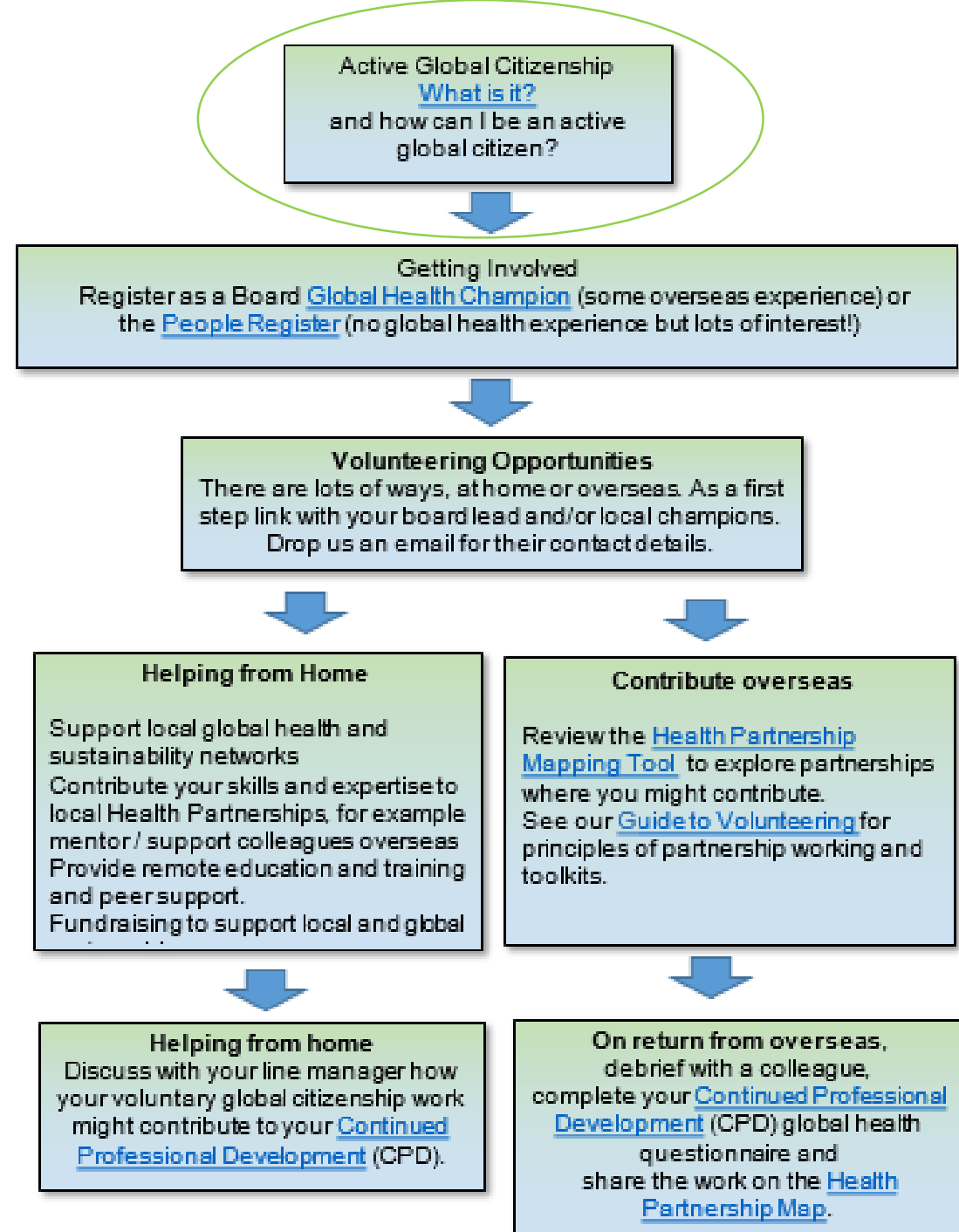
One in which our choices and actions may have benefits and repercussions for people and communities locally, nationally and internationally.”

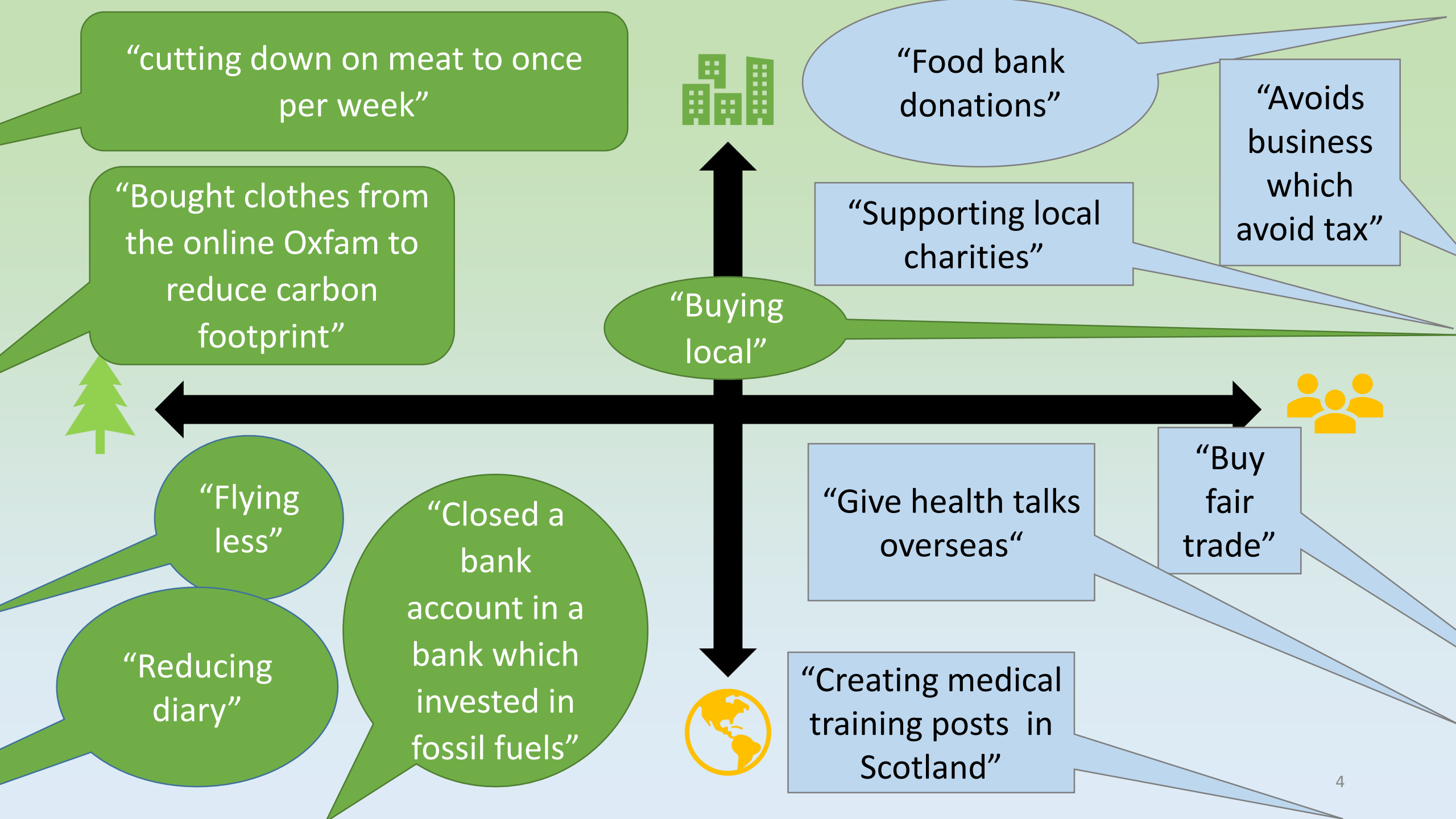

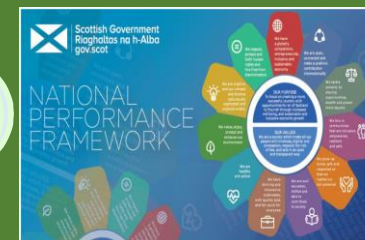
